Bubble Palace, Cannes


Currently the second most expensive home for sale in Europe, this revolutionary property of approximately 1,200m² was designed by the architect Antti Lovag. It was built between 1975 and 1989 and purchased by the farnous fashion designer Pierre Cardin in the early 1990s as a vacation home.

Taking the form of a cluster of bubbles spread over six levels, the property is at the forefront of contemporary architecture. It includes a panoramic lounge, reception room and 10 suites decorated by contemporary artists. A stunning 500-seat outdoor auditorium overlooks the sea, facing the bay of Cannes, while gardens, ponds and a swimming pool create a clifftop paradise stretching over more than 8,500m² of grounds.

France · Resplendent on the Riviera

By ALL ACCOUNTS, the French Riviera property market is booming, boosted by low interest rates, price falls inland, and an increase in sales in coastal locations, such as Cannes, Antibes and Saint Tropez. Tim Swannie at Home Hunts reports that buyers are now getting more for their money in locations such as Biot, Opio, Roquefortles-Pins and Châteauneuf de Grasse. "Grasse, the world capital of perfume, is also a great area for investments," he says. "The town is currently spending millions redeveloping the centre and there is a direct train line to Cannes and the rest of the Riviera."

Tim Clark of Leggett Prestige believes that the upcoming election in France will deliver a more proactive government and this has prompted the interest in highend property to increase.
